Did You Know ...

That UFDC is a charitable organization; that is, they depend upon doll clubs, individual members, and corporate sponsors to include them in their monthly, quarterly, or yearly donations to survive as an organization. Without these donations, UFDC would no longer exist - no DOLLS NEWS, no museum, no new dolly friendships, and no UFDC. At the 2011 Annual Meeting the Balance Sheet shows that for every UFDC member there is a negative of \$20.25 yearly; which means UFDC cannot continue to support itself on fees. UFDC members must remember that UFDC is a charitable organization and for this organization to survive members need to send contributions to UFDC on a regular basis either by individual members for donations that are fully tax-deductible on their yearly federal tax form as a charitable donation or the doll club, which is required by IRS codes to donate funds to a charitable organization yearly to keep up UFDC's 501(c)(3) corporation status as a charitable organization.

The UFDC dues are broken down in two parts. Part One of the fee is for the DOLL NEWS magazine and Part Two is for UFDC to help run the charitable organization. In 2008 the fee for the DOLL NEWS was increased by \$10.00 but the UFDC's fee has not been increased since 1999.

The DOLL NEWS magazine is an amazing magazine and when you breakdown their costs and UFDC's fee it's \$3.34 a month. Some clubs vote to pay the increase in the fee to be paid out of their club's treasury, which also makes the doll club's required charitable donation for the year! The club president adds this information to your Annual Club Activity Report (that is due April 1, 2012; or, past due April 1, 2011 by some Region 12 doll clubs and should be sent in ASAP) to show you have raised funds for the year. The Annual Club Activity Report is required by law and if this form is not sent in by all UFDC doll clubs, it can jeopardize UFDC's charitable status.

NOTE: When doll clubs do fundraisers for a specific charity, remember to give 10% or 20% (or more) of those funds raised to UFDC to show your support for this great organization!! Deadline for submitting items to me for the WINTER 2011 Newsletter is November 15, 2011.
