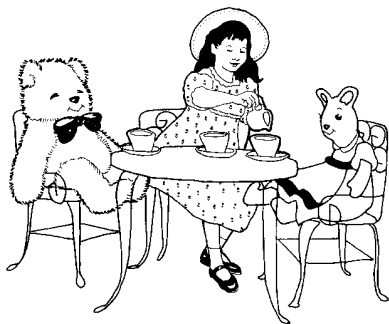
### **Fundraising**

As you know, the United Federation of Doll clubs is the premier doll organization because it is the most inclusive and has the largest membership. Keeping the UFDC strong not only promotes our own appreciation of doll collecting it also enhances related businesses. The museum and library offer extensive opportunities for education and research.

In the past the UFDC has been supported by memberships and profits from the annual convention. The past few years have seen a decline in attendance at convention and in total memberships. This has created a financial burden that can be rectified by offering increased opportunities for all to support the organization and to receive additional benefits which include

- the updated website which provides comprehensive member access to UFDC resources including access to the extensive research library and archival collection that will be available on-line soon.
- the museum, under the direction of the newly established Collections Committee, which is poised to grow and improve and become available through pages on the website.
- the resource library which offers programs that will be continually updated and increased.

Your club can help keep the UFDC strong and growing by donating just one doll a year to the newly established on-line auction offered on eBay. In order to keep the on-line auction going consistently, regions have been assigned for donations to one of the four quarters of the year using the following schedule.

In addition to clubs, individuals are encouraged to donate to make the on-line auction a success. Donated items are not limited to dolls and doll-related items; they might also include tickets to events, time-shares, artwork, decorative pieces, jewelry, accessories, fabrics, trims or any other items of interest. Please discuss this at your next club meeting and give careful consideration to supporting the UFDC in this way.

The on-line auction is scheduled to start October 1. To bid on an item 1) go to [www.ufdc.org](http://www.ufdc.org), 2) click the Home tab, 3) scroll down and click on the UFDC eBay link, 4) go to the large eBay window and click on the picture, 5) click on the blue View and Bid button.
